# SATURDAY MARCH 19, 2011

This show is for any Mustang, Shelby or Shelby Cobra, Ford, Mercury, Lincoln, or Ford Powered Car or Truck – whether in show condition or still a “work in progress”. All show vehicles *must be Ford Powered*. (Maximum show capacity 150 vehicles.)

**Location:** Town Square Plaza Park – 5010 81<sup>st</sup> Avenue North, Pinellas Park, FL

**Registration:** 8:00 AM – 10:00 AM

**Judging:** 10:30 AM – 2:30 PM

**Prizes and Awards:** 3:00 PM

**Directions:** From Interstate-275 take Exit 28 going west on Gandy Boulevard, Gandy turns into Park Boulevard after U.S. 19. Continue west on Park until 49<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and go to 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (*Joto's Pizza* on corner) and turn left. Town Square Plaza Park is located across the street from the Fire Station on the left side of 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. Look for Mustang Car Show Signs.

**Judging Information:** **Only Pre-Registered Cars will be judged.** Registrations must be post-marked **no later than** March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

All cars except Participant and 2010-11 cars will be judged using Modified MCA Judging. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Awards will be given in each class. Classes are listed on back.

**Definitions:** *Concours* = 100% stock/factory (except tires and safety items)

*Occasional Driven*: = 3 or less modifications (except tires and safety items), vehicle only used for shows and pleasure driving (cruise-ins etc.)

*Daily Driven*: = 3 or less modifications (except tires and safety items), vehicle used as principal transportation for owner/driver. Engine compartment and trunks will not be judged on this class.

*Modified*: = 4 or more modifications from “factory” version of vehicle, either mechanical or appearance items, clones included (example – Shelby Mustang “clone”)

Please register the car in the class that most accurately describes how it is used by the owner. During judging period, convertible tops should be up, passenger's side and rear windows should be up. Driver's side window should be ½ up. Hood and trunk must be open (except for Daily Driven Class)

Work in Progress Cars, Participant Only, and Cars Registered Day of Show **will not be judged.**
