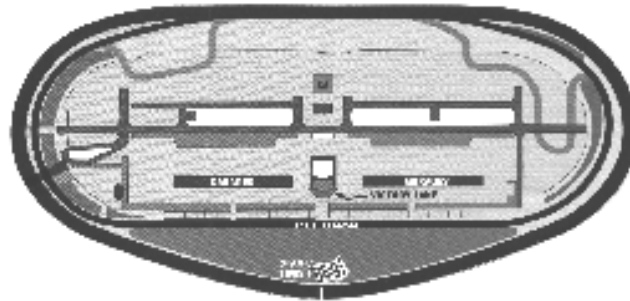

2011 Mustang



The 2011 Mustang will remain cosmetically unchanged since it had a few touch ups in 2010. The main change is under the hood with the return of the 5.0. The new 5.0 will produce 400 horsepower. And the 5.0 fender badges that were used from 1979 through 1993 will also be making their return. A new Duratec 3.7 V6 that produces about 275 horsepower will be used. The colors for 2011 will be Grabber Blue, Performance White, Black, Torch Red, Kona Blue, Sterling Grey, Brilliant Silver Metallic, Sunset Gold Metallic and Red Candy Metallic.
